As Historians, we will be exploring our ancient past, looking at Stone Age life and the transition to the Iron Age.

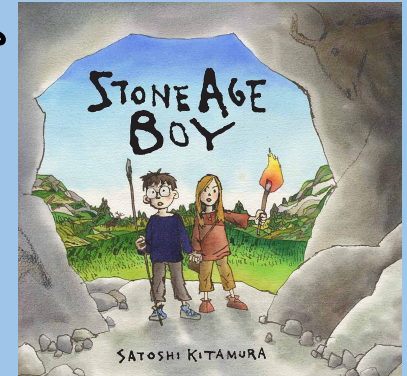
As Geographers, we will explore how the landscape of Britain would have appeared very different in Stone Age times.
