As Historians we will look at the how Native Americans lived before the arrival of the Europeans.

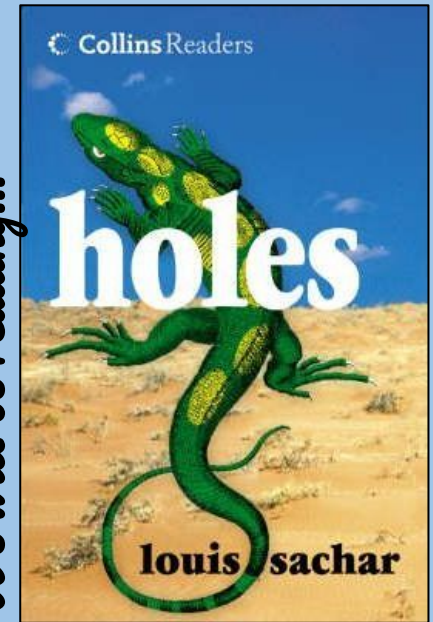
As Geographers we will explore North America.
