As writers we will learn to write in various styles including a biography, a newspaper and short stories.

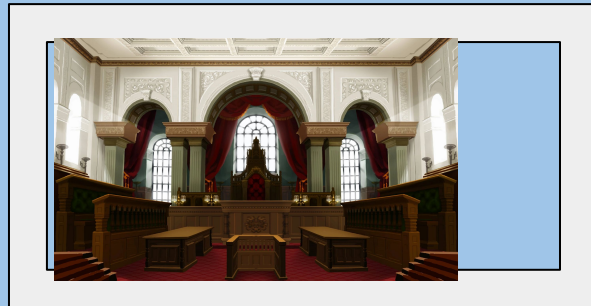
As mathematicians we increase our knowledge of Fractions, Decimals and Percentages.

As Historians we will learn about crime and punishment through the ages and the impact it has had on the world today.

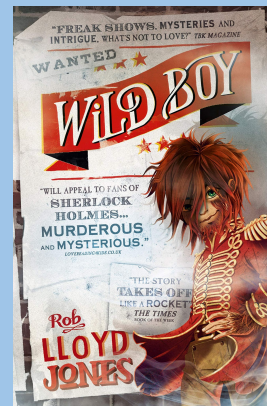
As Geographers we will conduct research of our local area to enable us to construct our own maps and keys.
