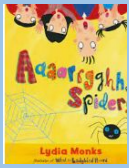
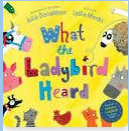
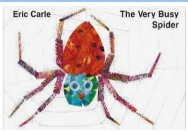

As **active learners** we will share a range of stories and poems, songs and games that explore minibeasts. We will begin to identify initial letter sounds of words and orally blend and segment sounds to create words. We will practice writing our names and make a class book about minibeasts. We will explore numbers from 0-20 and develop mathematical skills and understanding through everyday and structured activities.

As **creative explorers** we will investigate and explore a range of minibeasts. We will continue to talk about our play describing why things happen and what might happen.
