Ocean Life


Our Creative Curriculum

As **confident individuals** we will continue to use our knowledge of phonics to write independently for different purposes, including poems, lists, labelling and stories. We will work on a project, during Free Flow, for a sustained period of time, explaining what we want to achieve and what we can do to improve a piece of work. We will continue to work in new groups, in preparation for final classes in Year One.

As **successful learners** we will consolidate learning in numbers to 20. We will prepare for Year one by using number lines and other manipulatives to help us explain our reasoning. As successful readers we will learn to elaborate on ideas and explanations, using descriptive language.

As **active learners** we will focus on throwing and catching skills. We will continue to develop our gross motor skills on tricycles and on the climbing equipment at Forest schools and in the outdoors classrooms. We will spend more time (weather dependent) on the field for the summer term.

As **creative explorers** we will look at various sea and sky scapes by Hokusai, Turner and Monet, thinking about how colour is used to achieve depth. We will listen to the Beatles and Saint Saen's Aquarium. We will also listen to ocean and waves sounds tapes, making our own and considering if they help us during mindfulness exercises.



Global Citizens

Our **Jigsaw** theme for this term will be Changing Me. We will use this theme to think about how much we have changed over the year and how ready we are to move into Year One.

We will talk about water safety in the summer months.

As part of our Ocean Theme we will think about our impact of Sea dumping on the planet and about what we can do at school to keep our planet safe.

We will also learn about various types of Ocean Life and the impact that humans have on their chance of survival.

LOtC and WOW days

As part of our Outdoor Learning we will be observing the seasonal changes, particularly the bulbs we planted in the Autumn term and our Sunflowers.

We will use our Forest School time to problem solve, as a team, by working on Engineering Projects such as building boats and shelters.

We will visit the Horniman Museum Aquarium and we will take part in an under the Sea sensory workshop.
