As mathematicians we will be continuing to learn about fractions before learning about properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

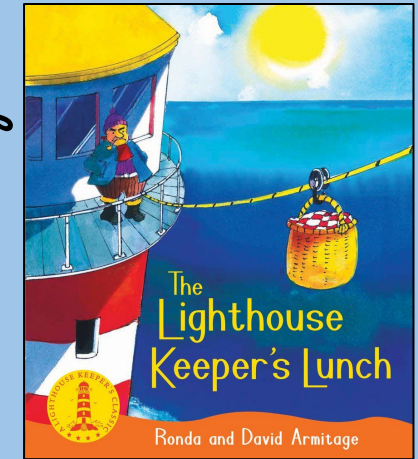
As historians we will be learning about all the fun and excitement of a day out at the seaside in Victorian times. We will learn about the changes in Victorian life that started this much-loved British tradition.
