As writers we will create backstories for characters in our class text. We will also create our own characters, writing descriptions and recounts about their lives.

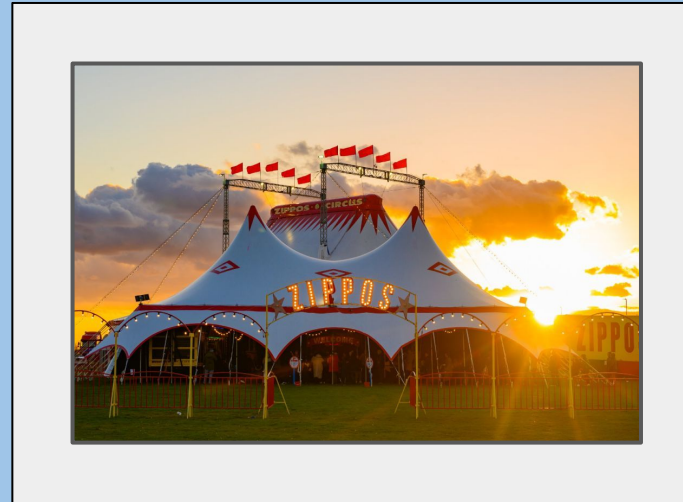
As mathematicians we will focus on time, mass and capacity. Learning about months and days in the year and how to accurately measure and estimate capacity and mass.

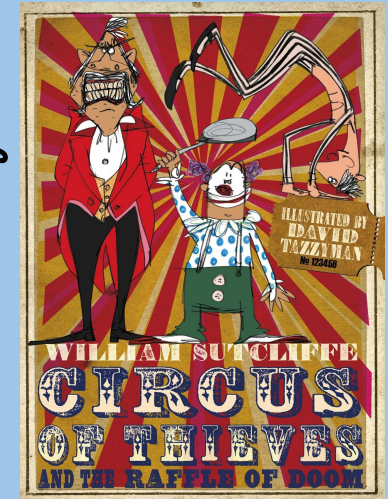
As Geographers we will find out about countries in and around Europe. Will we research and compare what the circus is like in different countries.
