As writers, we will be learning to write balanced arguments about animals in captivity, and a letter or diary entry about Nelson Mandela's imprisonment.

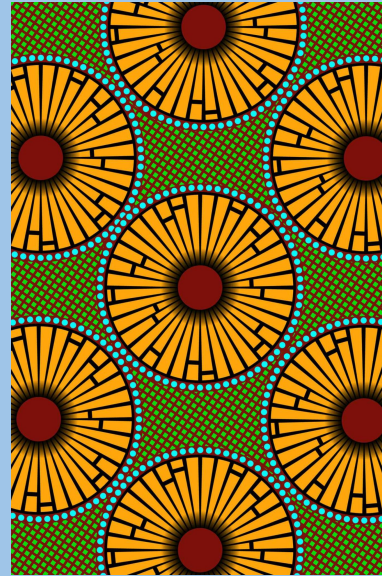
As mathematicians we will be learning about money and reviewing learning from earlier in the year.

As geographers we will be learning about the wondrous diversity of both human and physical features found on the continent of Africa.

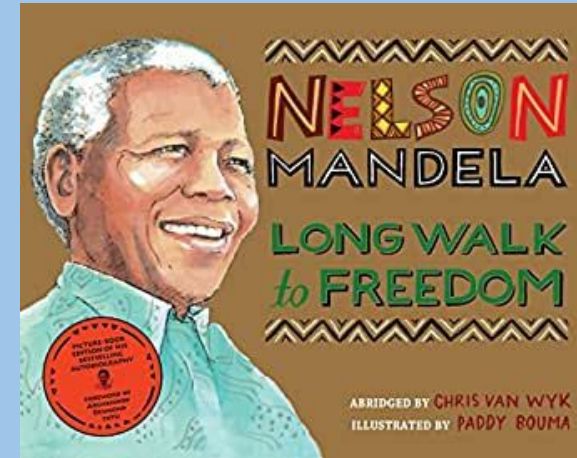
As historians we will explore the affects of colonialism in Africa, with a focus on Apartheid and Nelson Mandela's struggle for freedom.
